$openDate = strtotime($record['createdDate']);
$closeDate = strtotime($record['closedDate']);
$dateDiff = ($closeDate - $openDate);

$d = ($dateDiff/(60*60*24))%365;
$h = ($dateDiff/(60*60))%24;
$m = ($dateDiff/60)%60;

echo $d." days\n";
echo $h." hours\n";
echo $m." minutes\n";
?>
```
